Quesnel Awarded Minerals North 2020

Quesnel, B.C. – May 1, 2018 – The Minerals North Conference Association (MNCA) is pleased to announce Quesnel will be host for the 32nd annual Minerals North Conference and Trade Show in late April 2020. Minerals North is the annual gathering of northern BC communities and its minerals sector. It is a venue for establishing business contacts, for learning about current activity in mining and exploration in northern British Columbia and for healthy dialogue leading to responsible resource development. The combination of conference delegates and trade show participants can easily exceed 300 people.
