The Public Works Department requires a full-time seasonal Labourer – Ball Park Maintenance from mid-April to mid-September (both dates are weather dependent). This position, which reports to the Public Works Superintendent or his designate, is responsible for the maintenance of all ball fields within the City of Quesnel.

Nature of Position

The Labourer-Ball Park Maintenance is responsible for:

- dragging and preparing in-fields
- outfield grass repairs
- minor maintenance on underground sprinkler systems
- weed eating and hand mowing
- fence and backstop repairs
- washroom cleaning (where applicable)
- preparing specific parks for tournaments
- bleacher repairs and garbage pick up
- other labouring duties as assigned

Required Qualifications

At a minimum, the Labourer – Ball Park Maintenance should possess the following qualifications:

- Grade 12 Diploma
- Valid Class 5 driver's licence
- Experience in ball park maintenance, fencing, rotovating and general parks maintenance
- Familiarity with fertilizing techniques
- Physical ability to carry out duties
- Ability to communicate effectively in English with employees, supervisors and the public
- A professional and courteous disposition, especially when working under pressure
